More Natural Gas For Southland Being Sought

More natural gas for Southern California is being sought in a hearing before Public Utilities Commissioner Harold P. Huls, Southern California Gas Co. and Southern Counties Gas Co. are asking for approval of a plan to increase the capacity of their jointly owned Texas pipeline system to bring an additional 150 million cubic feet of natural gas daily into the state. The companies estimate the cost of the facilities will amount to about \$7½ million. The added gas would raise the total delivery capacity of the Texas pipeline system to 705 million cubic feet daily.

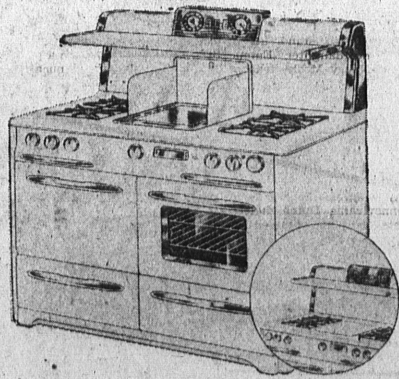
