
To Another, Says

About one-fifth of the state's traffic accident troubles can be blamed on the drinking drivers, the California Highway Patrol noted recently.

A new report covering a 12, month period shows that drivers who had been drinking figured in about 20 per cent of the total number of fatal and injury accidents in which a similar percentage of the total induries and deaths occurred. On the basis of provisional figures for 1952, this means that such drivers were responsible for about 725 deaths and more than 20,000 injuries lard year.

The "had been drinking" classification, the Patrol said, includes drivers obviously drunk and those "under the influence."

Men are overwheimingly the worst offenders, the Patrol said. Out of slightly more than 14,000 "had been drinking" drivers involved in fatal or injury accidents, 32 per cent were men. Ages of drinking drivers involved in accidents ranged from under 19 to over 65, the Patrol said, although most of them came from the 2534 age group with the 3544 bracket running second.
