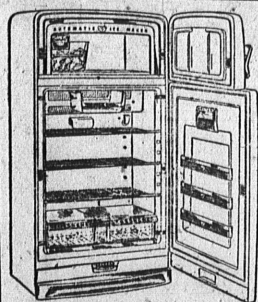
Local Soldier Graduates From Japan Radio School

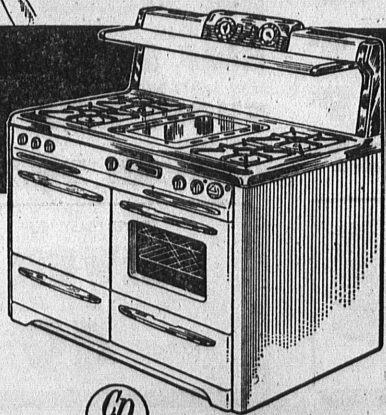
