

Local Youth Joins School

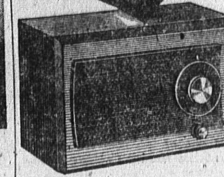

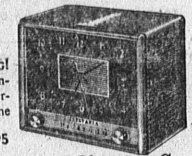

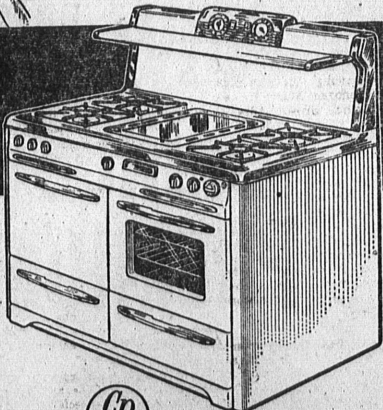
