Soul and Body Is Sunday's Lesson-Sermon

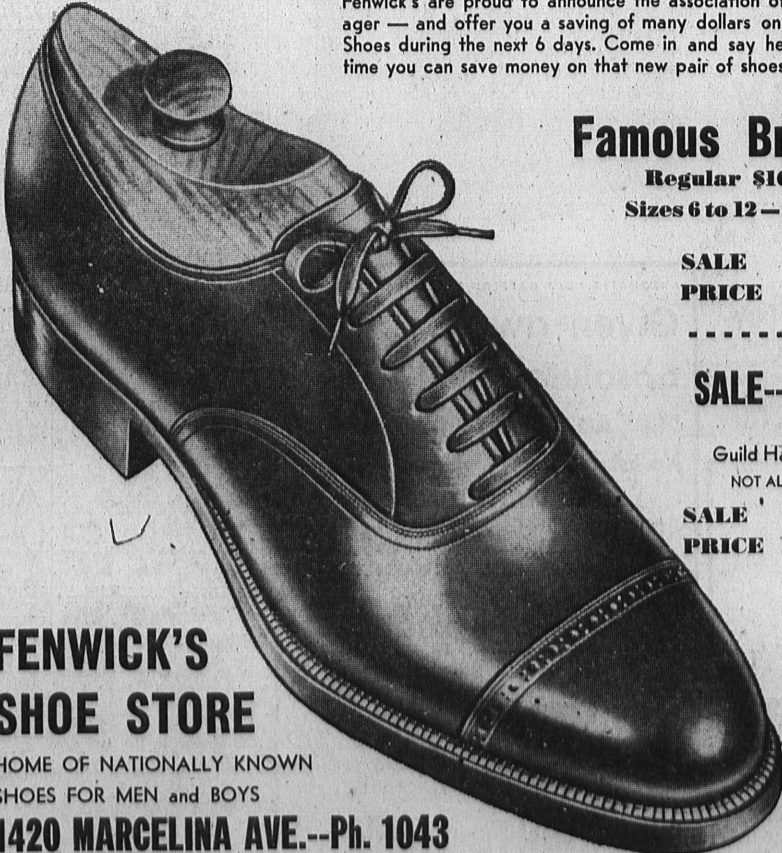
