1954 Chevrolet To Be Unveiled Here Tomorrow

The 1954 Chevrolet will be unveiled to the public for the first time tomorrow and Saturday at Paul's Chevrolet, 1640 Cabrillo, and on hand to entertain the kiddies will be a circus clown and merry-go-round, according to Paul Loranger, owner of the local dealership.

Chucko the Clown will appear Saturday at 3:30 p.m. with favors and tricks for the children and the merry-go-round will whirl tomorrow and Saturday, Loranger said.

Features of the new Chevrolet line, Loranger reported, are higher horsepower engines, power steering and power brake optional, a redesigned exterior and completely new interior, which includes automatic window and seat adjusters.

The Blue-Flame Engine, which goes with standard gearshift, has been stepped up to 115 horsepower, and the Blue-Flame 125, with the Powerglide transmission, is up to 125 horses.

Exterior changes include redesigned grille work to give a more massive and lower appearance to the car; parking lights under the headlights; bullet-shaped bumper guards; and rear lighting elements combined into one unit.
