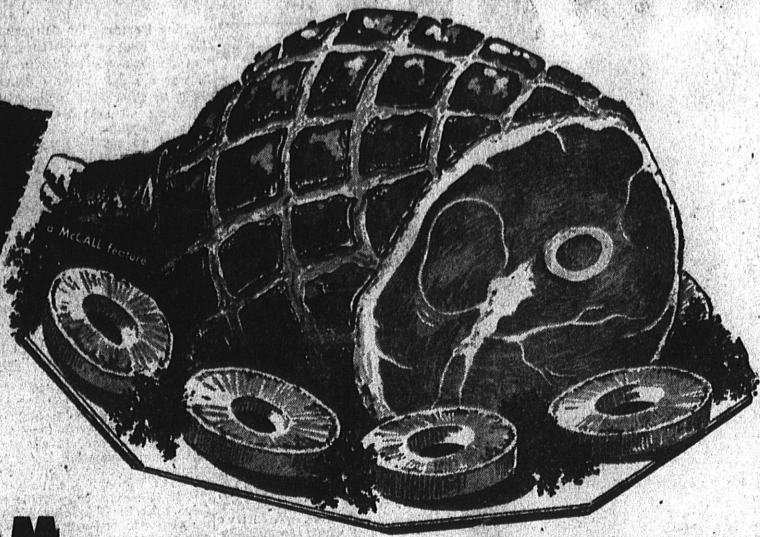

Ask Report on Water District

The County Board of Supervisors has ordered a report from the County Flood Control District on the engineering feasibility of creating a water conservation district covering the West Basin area.

Thus, the first step has been taken in a plan to form a zone for the levying of a special tax to raise about \$225,000 for the continuation and extension of the water barrier along the South Bay shoreline.

All legal requirements, including a public hearing, must be met by Feb. 1 if the zone is to be formed by June 30 of next year.
