ECC Continues Registration Until Feb. 15

Although second semester classes are now in session at El Camino College, registration for classes will remain open until Feb. 15, Forrest G. Murdock, president, announced this week. New enrollments will be taken in Room 2 of the Administration building of the college campus, located on Crenshaw between Manhattan Beach and Redondo Beach Blvds., he said. At the close of the regular registration period on Tuesday evening, 4293 students had signed for courses, the president continued. Over 100 students have registered since Tuesday, and several hundred additional sign-ups are anticipated by college personnel. Enrollment figures are now slightly above those listed at a comparable time last semester, Merl F. Sloan, director of student personnel at El Camino, revealed. To serve the needs of the spring semester enrollment, 650 classes are being offered by a staff of 116 faculty members, four new instructors having joined the El Camino staff since the close of the fall semester. Additional classes already have been added in the fields of mathematics, English, and psychology to fill increased registration demands. Heaviest enrollment to date has occurred in classes in radio, television, electronics, math, and engineering, it was indicated. Openings still remain in classes in history, social science, psychology, literature, theatre arts, philosophy, journalism, art, music, business, secretarial training, and vocational fields. Lines Relieving registration this semester was a pre-registration of 1532 students, El Camino officials announced.
