

Congressman King Pushing Bill Outlawing Commie Party in U. S.

Congressman Cecil R. King declared yesterday that "Congress will be derelict in its duty to the people if it does not enact legislation to brand as criminals and traitors those who knowingly and wilfully become, or remain, members of the Communist Party of the United States."

The veteran California legislator, who is author of the first bill introduced in Congress to outlaw the Communist Party, spoke in support of his measure before a House Judiciary Subcommittee which is studying such legislation.

This is the first time a legislative committee of the House has formally considered a proposal directed exclusively at outlawing the Communist Party and similar subversive organizations in the United States, King said. Chairman Louis E. Graham (R. Pa.) announced: "We are determined to put an all-comprehensive bill through in this session of Congress."

Congressman King told the committee the step of outlawing the Communist Party is "absolutely essential," declaring "it has become more and more evident in recent years that the Red conspiracy prevailing on our home front, which hides behind the very laws it seeks to abolish, could prove more dangerous than an armed foe."

King's anti-Red measure has received the endorsement of the American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Machinists' Union, the Los Angeles City Council, and many other civic and patriotic organizations. Currently pending before the California Legislature is a resolution introduced last week by Assemblyman Allen Miller and 21 co-authors asking Congress to back the legislation outlawing the Communists.

Could Be President
In urging committee adoption of his measure King pointed out that under current security regulations a Communist cannot hold a Federal job, but a Communist can still legally seek public office as high as the President of the United States. "Such an inconsistency should certainly be eliminated," he declared.

Started in State
Long a foe of Communism, Congressman King said he cast his recent vote to outlaw the Communist Party 14 years ago when he was a member of the California State Legislature. He introduced his current bill (H. R. 8941) in Congress last June.

A companion measure was introduced in the Senate by Senator Margaret Chase Smith (R. Maine).

Congressman Graham, committee chairman, announced intentions of settling the question "once and for all" at this session and said he will invite "if necessary, the Communist Party itself" to testify on the bill which would make membership in the party illegal.

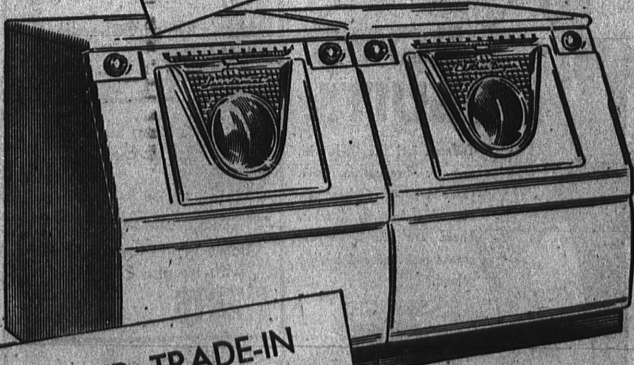
