**EC Editor Feted
At SC Press Day**

New honors in journalism were awarded Joe Rothstein, editor of the El Camino College Warhoop, Saturday at the 29th annual Newspaper Day of the University of Southern California.

Competing with contestants from junior colleges throughout all of Southern California, Rothstein was recognized as the top editorial writer of the year. In gaining the distinction, the college editor came near to duplicating a feat he performed at the USC press day last year when he emerged the outstanding sports writer among junior college contestants.

Entered also in feature and news writing classifications last year, Rothstein nabbed third place honors in these categories. During his editorship this year, Rothstein originated the Whoopla, a literary-humoristic magazine which attracted widespread attention on campus for its originality of style and format. He is a former editor-in-chief of the Olympian, weekly newspaper of Leuzinger High School, where he was graduated in 1952.

Speaking to the audience of over 400 high school and junior college students attending the USC Newspaper Day activities were Clinton D. McKinnon, publisher of the Los Angeles Daily News and Mary Ann Callan, women's editor of the Los Angeles Times.

Other El Camino journalism students attending the event were Glenda Homes, Ingiewood; Judy Applebaum, Hawthorne; and Fred Claire and David Par-ton of Torrance. They were accompanied by W. A. Kamrath, publications advisor of El Camino College.

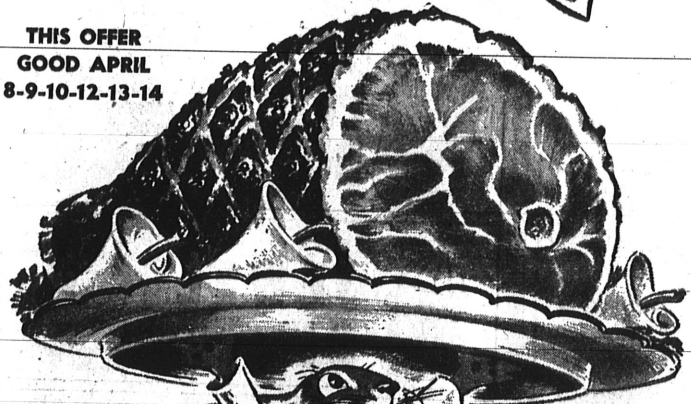

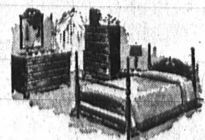
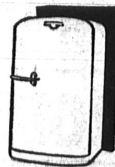
