

Walteria Church To Re-enact Passover Rites

Rev. Andrew Duty, pastor of the First Baptist Church, announces a colorful re-enactment of the Jewish Passover, to be given in his church, Park and Newton Sts., Walteria, on Sunday, April 11, at 7:30 p.m. This pageant is appropriate to the Easter season. 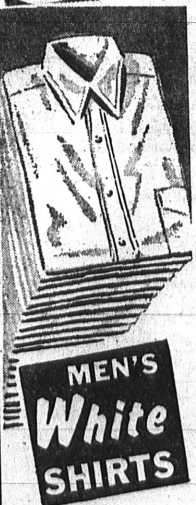

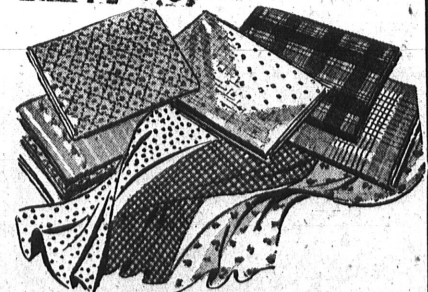
