Candidate Discusses Contracts With Local Aircraft Officials

Robert H. Finch, candidate for Congress in the 17th District, this week met with Federal Small Business Administrator Wendell B. Barnes and representatives of local privately owned aircraft sub-contracting firms to discuss government contract policy.

Meeting with Barnes and Finch were Mrs. Christina Wentworth, executive assistant, and Thomas J. May, assistant to the president, Longren Aircraft Co., Torrance.

"We are seeking the establishment of policies which will guarantee small, bona fide, privately owned and financed firms a fair share of the sub-contract work on large government contracts, such as aircraft assemblies," Mrs. Wentworth said. "The present danger is that the large contractors will be forced to keep all the work in their own plants, thus crippling many small firms which have with their own money and effort, built up facilities and trained personnel for doing the same jobs."
