Warwhoop Wins National Honor

All-American honors in the field of junior college newspapers were awarded the Warwhoop, El Camino College weekly news paper, recently by the Associated Collegiate Press, a rating service with headquarters at the University of Minnesota.

Announcement of the award was made by Merl F. Sloan, director of student personnel at the college. El Camino was one of six junior college weeklies in its classification to gain the distinction, Sloan noted.

In its seven-year history, the Warwhoop gained honors only once before, winning a first class award two years ago. At that time, the paper was judged winner of the Edward L. Dickson award at UCLA, a trophy presented to the outstanding junior college paper of Southern California. The All-American award is highest awarded by ACP.

Eleven JCs Honored
Eleven junior colleges of 68 entered in all classifications received top award, while a total of 66 four-year and two-year college newspapers out of 884 were named All-American, rating sheets indicated.

In compiling the Warwhoop's score, Marjorie Benson, a judge, commented that the El Camino publication is a colorful student paper with attractive layouts and worthwhile copy.

In an accompanying letter to the staff, the Associated College Press wrote: "Your staff can be justly proud of its outstanding achievement."

The Warwhoop was judged particularly high in its balance of coverage of news sources, creativeness of feature stories, lead paragraph writing, headline types, and over-all page make-up.

Joe Rothstein of Hawthorne is editor of the campus publication as well as Commissioner of Publications and a member of the student council on campus. Assisting him on the editorial staff during the first semester were Judy Applebaum, also of Hawthorne, news editor; Dick Doss, Inglewood, and Carl Larsen, Torrance, feature editors; and Fred Claire of Torrance, sports editor.

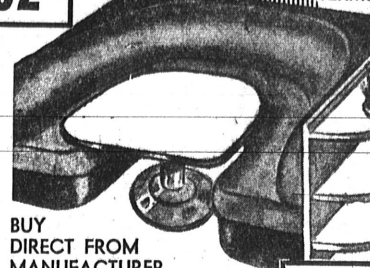
