Sacramento Report

People living along the coast of the 46th Assembly District, including residents of Portuguese Bend, Rolling Hills, Palos Verdes Estates, Hollywood Riviera, Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, El Segundo and Playa del Rey, write to me constantly about the possibility of great pools of oil offshore. Some of these good people are afraid that the oil companies will ruin the scenery by erecting derricks along the coast and others do not seem to worry about hurting the scenery but want oil development offshore as a source of revenue to relieve the taxpayers of part of their present tax burden.

Geologists on the faculties of universities and oil corporation executives tell me that oil produced from under the sea costs three times as much to find, produce and deliver to shipping points as onshore oil. This increased cost and the longer period before any return can be made on the money invested combine to eliminate small companies from accomplishing much in offshore oil development. The large companies are interested in acquiring rights for future use but I do not believe that there is any present threat to our coast from that source.

All-Out Smog Program
Fundamentally, getting rid of smog is a municipal and county problem, but the State government can help in various ways. We can enact laws which give local boards, commissions, councils, and county supervisors more authority than they now possess. Also, we can enact laws granting certain tax exemptions to partially offset the cost of installing smog-preventing devices and equipment. Also, we can provide for research on the part of State organizations and institutions. There are only a few of the possibilities for State help in an all-out program to get rid of smog, but it must be remembered that there is no cheap, quick and easy solution to the problem.

Improving Our Beach
State, county and local governments are all working together now to improve our beach and harbor facilities. We have elaborate plans for the development of the small-boat harbor north of Playa del Rey, a beach and small harbor south of Playa del Rey (sometimes called the Westport area), the beach at Manhattan Beach, the beach and pier at Hermosa Beach, and, of course, Redondo Beach will benefit greatly from the \$150,000 appropriation which we voted in March, this year. Catalina Island is privately owned, hence it does not come within the scope of county or state financial assistance.

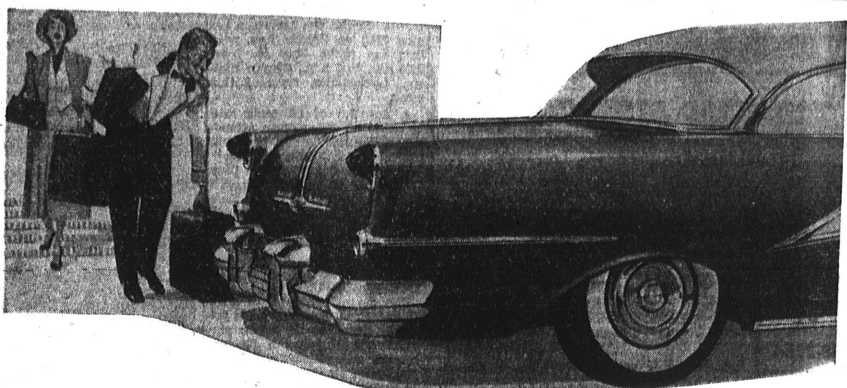

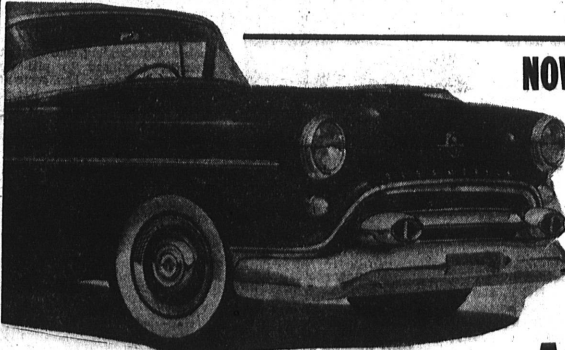
