



Minister Takes Temporary Post At Local Church

The Rev. J. J. Walker, long-time minister in the Christian Church, has been called upon to act as temporary minister at the First Christian Church of Torrance until a new minister can be chosen to replace the Rev. C. J. England, who resigned recently.

The Rev. Walker will act as ad interim minister and bring a wealth of experience from over 40 years in the Disciples of Christ Brotherhood. He entered the ad interim field two-and-a-half years ago and recently returned to California after serving four months in that capacity with the First Christian Church of Florence, Ala.

Thirty-five of the Rev. Walker's forty years of service to the church were spent in the south, where he was born. His first pastorate was in Greenville, N. C., where he was influential in building the Eighth St. Christian Church, and where he spent 11 years.

After serving as a YMCA secretary during World War I, he entered Vanderbilt University, where he received his MA degree. After seven years as a minister at the Woodland St. Church in Nashville, Tenn., he went to Memphis, Tenn., where he served as pastor for 23 years and helped the congregation build a new \$18,000 church.

He became the president of the president of the Council of Churches in Memphis and was a leader in civic affairs there. He is a 32nd degree Mason. For his first Sunday sermon to the Rev. Walker has chosen "Sounding the Great Recall."
