California Bank Profit Announced

California Bank's net profits for the six-month period ended June 30, amounted to \$1,399,929 equal to \$1.75 a share as compared with \$1,242,615, or \$1.40 a share in the like period a year ago, A. O. Otseva, vice-president of the Torrance Office of California Bank, reported yesterday.

Total resources amounted to \$639,462,762 up more than \$54,000,000 in the last 12 months, according to the bank's June 30 statement of condition. Deposits advanced to \$600,257,133 from \$549,298,119 a year ago. Loans and discounts totaled \$190,918,500 an increase of about \$4,500,000, the banker said.

Capital funds of \$28,882,307 consisted of capital and surplus of \$10,000,000 each and undivided profits of \$8,882,307.
