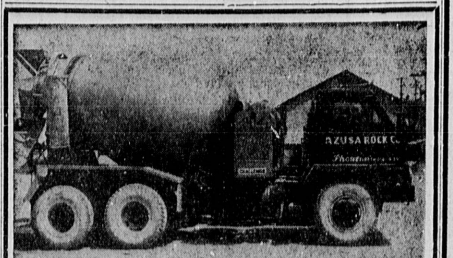
Lomita Church Buys New Building Site

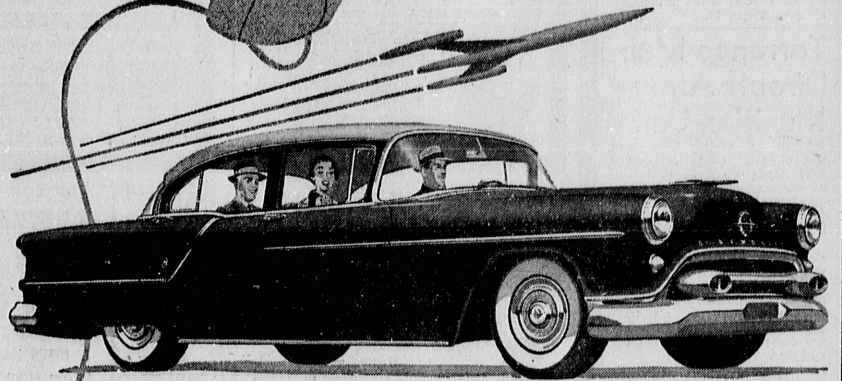
