He also attended the same class at the same college as the Rev. and Mrs. Turner.

National Guardsmen To Leave For Summer Camp Tomorrow Night

Thousands of National Guardsmen members of Southern California's 40th Armored Division, will leave their hometowns shortly after midnight tomorrow (Friday) bound for Hunter-Liggitt Military Reservation, near King City, Calif.

The convoys of military trucks and commercial busses converging on the Central California reservation from widely separated Southern California points will mark the first stage of the National Guard's organization's annual summer encampment.

More than 5000 men and officers will undergo the two-week period of field training this year, according to Maj. Gen. Homer O. Eaton Jr., the 40th's commander. In increase of approximately 3500 men recruited since last year's summer training session.

The 15-day period of field training will be the division's first experience in its new role as an assigned organization. It was redesignated as the 40th Armored Division July 1 after 38 years and three tours of overseas combat duty—as an infantry unit.

To Leave By Bus
The 40th maintains units in 50 communities, in an area extending from Santa Maria to San Diego, and from the coast inland as far as Barstow. All units are slated to leave home armories at 0601 hours Saturday military time—one minute after midnight Friday—said division transport officers. Commercial busses will be chartered to augment the division's own military vehicles. Routes and convoys speeds will be carefully coordinated to "spread" them on the highways to reduce interference with traffic.

The 40th will wind up its training during the two weeks period of armored warfare. General Eaton, with main operations of tanks and heavy equipment, and the many types of weapons used by an armored division in top priority.

Motorists Warned to Keep Clear of 'Suicide Lane'

Beware of "Suicide Lane," the California Safety Council has warned motorists. "This," pointed out Raymond F. Leheny, Council President, "is the center lane, next to the double white line. When you hug the center lane the distance of separation between you and the on-coming traffic is about 10 inches. This means that the slightest loss of control of your car will throw you into a head-on collision."

Statistics show, continued Leheny, that nine out of 10 cars when the brakes are applied other occupants were left in the hospital. There undoubtedly have been others throughout California, but there need be no more if every driver will take his right responsibility when behind the wheel of his car, Leheny continued.

The California Safety Council urges every driver to sign a safe driving pledge. In order to reduce the State's traffic accident rate by 20% everyone must cooperate, Leheny emphasized.

Since the beginning of the summer there have been two such accidents in Los Angeles County. One resulted in a fatality and the other as yet undetermined, but

CHP Outlines Typical Crash Victim Profile

With the heavy highway fatality months of the year coming up, the National Safety Council and its California Chapters took time out yesterday for a look at the state's "composite" traffic victim.

According to the Annual Statistical Report (1953) prepared by the California Highway Patrol, here is a profile of last year's "victim:"

He was a male driver between the ages of 25 and 35 years. He was killed on a Sunday in the month of December between the hours of 6 and 7 p.m.

The fatal accident took place between intersections and was the result of a collision with another motor vehicle.

Although "no apparent condition" was listed as contributing to the accident, misuse of speed headed all reported driver violations for the year.
