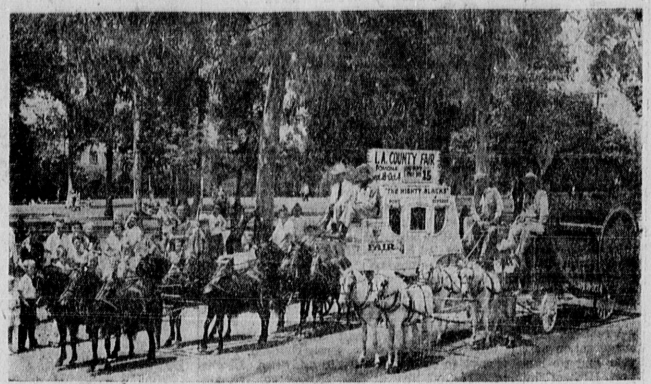
Driving Errors Cost 8 Permits
