Church leaders pointed out that the Rev. Walker was the inspiration for the church's building program which saw completion of several units of a new church here this year.

The pastor was also credited with bringing 160 new members into the congregation during his year here.

Sermon on 'Substance' Set Sunday

That the abundance of good is ever available to meet the needs of man will be discussed in the Lesson-Sermon on "Substance" in all Christian Science churches Sunday.

In the time of famine the widow of Zarephath, obedient to Elijah's request, found her depleted store abundantly increased. As recorded in I Kings (17:16), "the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the Lord, which he spake by Elijah."

Mary Baker Eddy defines "Only" in "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" as: "Consecration; charity; gentleness; prayer; heavenly inspiration."
