AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 649 CONTINUING A THREE-STEP PLAN AND MAKING CHANGES IN THE SALARIES OF THE VARIOUS POSITIONS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Torrance, in Ordinance No. 649, adopted a three-step pay range plan, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Torrance desires to establish changes in the salaries of certain positions in the classified service in the City of Torrance applicable to the new pay range;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the position classification plan, as now being used in the City of Torrance, be and the same is hereby adopted, subject to such changes and modifications as may from time to time be recommended by the City Manager, Civil Service Board, or Personnel Board, and approved by the City Council.

**SECTION 2.** The following positions are hereby added to the position classification plan and salary schedule of the City of Torrance:

The City Clerk will certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published in the Torrance Herald, semi-weekly newspaper published, printed and circulated in the City of Torrance, and said newspaper hereby designated for that purpose.
