**Arbitration Planned**  
 Submission of the board's differences with the Winter Construction Co. to a three-man arbitration board was approved.  
 The board has refused to pay \$2500 to the company claiming that work at Carr School on a concrete sidewalk and lavatory facilities was not according to standards, and that floors are uneven.  
 School Superintendent J. H. Hull told the board he had written the state, requesting that white lines be painted across 174th St., at intersections which children will use to go to Perry, North Torrance, and Carr schools.
