

Moose Safety Competition Ends Oct. 1

The judging committee of the Torrance Moose Lodge will begin next week to rate entries in the local division of the Moose International Youth Safety Award Contest, according to Joseph Platt, governor and civic affairs chairman.

The winner will be a boy or girl whom the judges consider has done the most outstanding safety service in the area during the contest.

Heroism is not necessarily a requirement, Platt said. School safety activities—patrol, safety themes or posters, and related actions make them eligible, he said.

An embossed parchment-like scroll will be presented to the local winner, who will compete with more than 1700 other local winners throughout North America for four grand prizes. These include a trip to either New York or Chicago to appear on a national radio or TV show, gold wrist watches, and a trip to Washington, D. C. and the White House.

Plants Help Outdoor Life

Flowers and shrubs offer a welcome addition to garden, patio, or outside living areas, suggests the California Association of Nurserymen.

If a home has a porch or patio, potted flowers and container-grown plants can be intermingled among the regular furnishings for greater attractiveness. Container-grown cannolias, gardenias, coleus and acuba can add beauty. Azaleas, rhododendrons, fuchsias are also possibilities for porch, patio, terrace or lanai. Ferns help temper the weather where Summer and Fall warmth is a problem.

A hothouse or screened-in area outdoors can also add much if established. In such situations hanging basket plants are in their element.

A glassed-in porch is recommended in areas where the weather becomes difficult in early fall. Built-in flower beds, ferns and many tropical plants are appropriate for such a location.

A large tree can be the center of activity. Low growing plants about the base of an old oak and a table and chairs so that outdoor meals may be served.
