GLORIFIED ANGEL CAKE

GLORIFIED ANGEL CAKE
BEAT 6 egg yolks until lemon colored.
ADD 34 cup sugar gradually.
ADD 1½ tsp. lemon rind, ¾ cup lemon juice.
PUT into double boiler and cook until mixture coats spoon.
Set off fire.
SOFTEN 1½ envelopes gelatin in ¼ cup cold water.
ADD egg mixture to galatin mixture.

SOFTEN 1½ envelopes gelatin in ¼ cup cold water. ADD egg mixture to gelatin mixture. PUT into refrigerator and stir occasionally until slightly fiickened and cool.

MEANWHILE, cut angel food cake into 1 inch cubes. BEAT 6 egg whites until almost stiff.
ADD ¼ cup of sugar to egg whites and beat until stiff. FOLD beaten egg whites into cool egg yolk mixture. PUT some in bottom of an angel food cake pan. COAT pieces of angel food cake with mixture and REMOLD in angel food cake pan. CHILL cake.

CHILL CARE.
FROST cake with whipped cream and garnish with red and green cherries.
