ORDINANCE NO. 715
 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV, ORDINANCE NO. 446.
 The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows: THAT public convenience and necessity requires that traffic control installations be established on certain streets in and for the City of Torrance, and that the following regulatory traffic signs be established on the following streets:
ONE HOUR PARKING LIMIT on the following:
 1. Cabrillo Avenue—31th Street to Torrance Blvd.
 2. Carson Street—Border Avenue to Arlington Avenue.
 3. Cravens Avenue—Carson Street to Engracia Avenue.
 4. El Prado Avenue—Cravens Avenue to Cabrillo Avenue.
 5. Gramercy Avenue—Cabrillo Avenue to Alley S. W. of Cravens.
 6. Marcellina Avenue—Cabrillo Avenue to Alley S. W. of Cravens.
 7. Post Avenue—Torrance Blvd. to Alley S. W. of Cravens.
 8. Torrance Blvd.—Border Avenue to Cota Street.
 9. Sartori Avenue—Carson Street to Torrance Blvd.
TWO HOUR PARKING LIMIT on the following:
 1. Engracia Avenue—Torrance Blvd. to Alley S. W. of Cravens.
 2. Post Avenue—Alley S. W. of Cravens to Arlington Ave.
 3. Marcellina Avenue—Alley S. W. of Cravens to Arlington Ave.
 4. Gramercy Avenue—Alley S. W. of Cravens to Carson Street.
 5. Cravens Avenue—Engracia Avenue to Torrance Blvd.
 The aforementioned regulatory signs have been determined by the Traffic Commission as necessary under Ordinance No. 446, Article IV, and the City Traffic Chief, under said Ordinance and Article, is hereby authorized and directed to erect such signs.
 The City Council hereby declares that the increased usage by the automobile driving public of these streets has created a traffic hazard which demands the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of all citizens traversing said streets, whether by automobile or on foot, and, basing its conclusion upon the aforesaid statement, declares that an urgency exists and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after the passage and adoption hereof.
 The City Clerk will certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper published, printed and circulated in the City of Torrance, and said newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose.
