ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
 Notice is hereby given that the Board of Education, Torrance Unified School District, hereinafter called the District, will receive sealed proposals until 2:00 P.M. Thursday, February 3, 1955 for the construction of the STEELE SCHOOL.

In general, the work comprises the construction of a kindergarten building, four classroom buildings, a multi-use building and administrative building, located on the District's real property situated on the east side of Imperial Avenue between Darwin and Narrot Streets in the City of Torrance, California.

Plans and Specifications are available on a loan basis upon deposit of \$25.00 at the office of the District or at the office of Wilber C. Harrison and Quinto Engineers, Ltd., 412 West Eighth Street, Los Angeles 17, California.

Each bid must be accompanied by a check certified by a responsible bank, or by a satisfactory bond, payable to the order of the Torrance Unified School District for an amount not less than five (5) per cent of the aggregate sum of the Bid, as a guarantee that the bidder will enter in the proposed contract if awarded to him, and furnish the necessary faithful performance and labor and material bonds.

Each bid shall be provided in duplicate on the forms submitted thereto and shall be sealed and filed in the office of the Business Manager or before the date shown above.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 1770 of the Labor Code, the District has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages applicable to the work to be done, to be as follows:

It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom a contract is awarded and upon all subcontractors prevailing wage scale in accordance with the provisions of section 1770 of the Labor Code, to all workmen employed in the execution of this contract.

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Education of the Torrance Unified School District of Los Angeles County will receive bids for furnishing school supplies, equipment and repairs as per list and specifications on file in the office of the Business Manager, 255 1/2 Plaza Del Amo, Torrance, California.

Each bid must be submitted on a printed form furnished by the Board of Education, must be sealed and filed in the Business Manager's office on or before Friday, Jan. 21, 1955, at 10:00 a.m. and will be opened in public at that time and place and each bid aggregating \$1,000 or over, 5% of the total amount of the bid, or cashier's check for not less than 5% of the total amount of the bid, provided that if only certain items of the above substitute a certified or cashier's check for 5% of the aggregate amount of the accepted items on his bid, and providing further that firms doing business regularly with the Board of Education may at the discretion of the Business Manager and in lieu of the above mentioned check, file with the Business Manager of the Torrance Unified School District, an annual or continuing surety company's bond in the amount of not less than \$5,000.00 and signed by the terms of their signed bid submitted from time to time during the life of the bond. The above mentioned check or bidder's bond shall be given a minimum of 10 days before the bid is to be opened and if the bidder fails to comply with the terms of the bid, after acceptance of the bid, his check or bond will be forfeited.

Other conditions being equal, preference will be given to the products of the State of California.

The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or any part of a bid, and to waive any informality in the bids received.

Firms or individuals desiring to submit bids from time to time on school supplies and equipment, shall list themselves with said Business Manager of the Torrance Unified School District.
