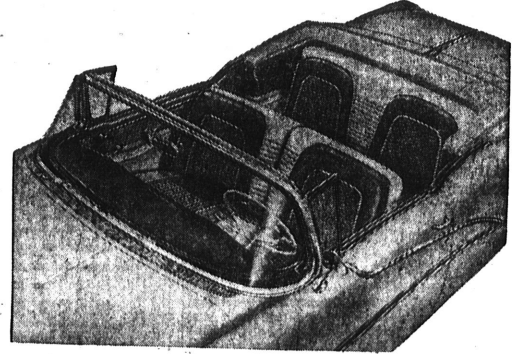

 SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY hereby gives notice that a Supplemental Application to its Application No. 34875 was filed with the California Public Utilities Commission on January 14, 1955, requesting authorization of the Commission to increase the gas rates to gas service supplied firm customers. The amount of additional annual gross revenue sought is approximately \$6,000,000, which amount is equal to the increased cost of natural gas purchased from El Paso Natural Gas Company, based on estimated 1955 volumes. The requested increase is contingent upon the price of gas purchased from the latter company and is subject to possible refund. The amount requested is a 6.4% increase for firm customers.
