Right of way anatchers cause of every seven traffic accidents in unincorporated areas.

California Highway Patrol records indicate that 9605 accidents of the 67,256 investigated by the Patrol during 1954 resulted from vlolation of either pedestrian or motor vehicle right of way.

"Much of our right of way' difficulty apparently develops from a negative approach to the problem in actual driving practice," declared Patrol Commissioner B. R. Caldwell.

"According to law, 'right or way' is the privilege of the Immediate use of the highway. Sections of the vehicle code dealing with specific problems or right of way stipulate which vehicle or driver shall yield.

"If motorists would approach infersections, calculate passing attempts, and enter the traffic atream from parking positions asking: 'Is it safer to wait?' rather than Can I get away with this?' the number of accidents caused by right of way violations would drop considerably." Caldwell explained.

"In almost every instance of right of way violations there is thoughtlessness, selfishness, or ignorance of the law. In each of these cases the driver has the power to remedy the situation," he added.
