

This universal means of locomotion is one exerces which,
like gardening, can be continued throughout life. A first-rate
hody conditioner, it is also a
tonic for the mind.

One would expect to find
ideal walking conditions easily
enough but such is not the
case. The very distances in this
area are discouraging. So far
do they stretch into space, as
a matter of fact, that walking
around Los Angeles is rarely
considered and still more rarely done. Indeed, many new housing developments covering large
amounts of territory do not
even provide sidewalks for pedestrians.

Abdominal and back muscles are exercised when the individual walks correctly. This is done by making oneself as tail as possible without straining, and by pulling the stomach in and up. The head is kept erect, the chin in. Needless to say, the individual should always be provided with comfortable walking shoes.
