**ORDINANCE NO. 745**  
 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV, ORDINANCE NO. 146.  
 The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby order as follows:  
 THAT public convenience and necessity requires that traffic control installations be established on certain streets in said City.  
 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE that the following regulatory traffic signs be established on the following streets:  
 That commercial vehicles with over two and one-half ton gross weight be prohibited on the following streets:  
 (a) On Atkinson Avenue between 174th and 176th Streets.  
 That aforementioned regulatory signs have been determined by the Traffic Commission as necessary, as per Ordinance No. 145, Article IV, and the City Traffic Chief, under said Ordinance and Article, is hereby authorized and directed to install said signs.  
 The City Council hereby declares that the increased usage by the automobile driving public of these streets has created a traffic hazard which demands the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of its citizens traversing said streets, whether by automobile, pedestrian or otherwise.  
 In conclusion upon the aforesaid statement, declares that an urgent exists and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after the passage and adoption hereof.  
 The City Clerk will certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper published, printed and circulated in the City of Torrance, and said newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose.

 (b) LOCATION ON PROPERTY. Location of such structures and devices regulated by this ordinance shall be such as to provide adequate safety to the occupants of, or access from said structure or device, or adjacent structures or devices, in case of fire or panic.  
 (c) CONSTRUCTION. All structures or devices regulated by this ordinance shall be constructed and maintained as required in Section 1 of this ordinance.  
 (d) SPECIAL SAFETY MEASURES. In case of doubt, the Building Official may order such use or occupancy discontinued by notice in writing served on any person engaged in using or occupying or causing to be used or occupied such structure or device, and all such persons shall forthwith discontinue such use or occupancy until authorized by the Building Official to continue the same.  
 SECTION 2.  
 (a) GENERAL. This section shall

 (a) EXIT FACILITIES. Exits and exit passageways shall be provided from or between structures or devices to insure safety in case of panic or disaster.  
 (b) SPECIAL HAZARDS. A adequate fire extinguishing apparatus shall be provided subject to the approval of the Fire Marshal of the City of Torrance.  
 (c) REINSPECTION. The Building Official may cause all structures and devices regulated by this ordinance to be reinspected, and fees for such inspection shall be paid as required by Section 308 of the Uniform Building Code.  
 SECTION 3.  
 This ordinance is hereby declared an urgency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, general welfare and continued progress of the City of Torrance and this ordinance, therefore, shall take effect and be in full force immediately after the passage and adoption thereof.

**Public Notice**  
 (a) PERMITS. No person shall erect or construct, or proceed with the erection or construction of any public assembly tent, amusement device, boat, conveyer, or other structure regulated by this ordinance without first filing an application and obtaining a permit therefor from the Building Official. A permit shall be required each time said structure is erected or moved.  
 (b) CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS. Amusement devices, freight hoists, conveyers and all structures, equipment or devices regulated by this ordinance, whether specifically mentioned or not, shall be made structurally safe, with due allowance for impact, wear and injury during use.
