RESOLUTION NO. 2725
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO VACATE A CERTAIN WALKWAY IN TRACT 1818 IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE, FIXING A TIME WHEN THE CITY COUNCIL WILL MEET TO TAKE FINAL ACTION THEREON AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS RESOLUTION.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does resolve as follows:
WHEREAS, the City Council has been petitioned to vacate a certain walkway in Tract No. 1818 within the City of Torrance, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A 6-foot Walkway between Lots 112 and 118 of Tract 1818, as recorded in Map Book 457, pages 35-38 inclusive, in the Office of the County Recorder, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

WHEREAS, such vacation will cause no hardship of any kind to adjacent property owners; and **WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission of the City of Torrance has recommended approval of said petition to vacate said walkway; and the said City Council herewith declares its intention to vacate said walkway;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Walkway to be vacated, and the details of said vacation, are more particularly shown upon a map bearing the legend "MAP SHOWING PROPOSED VACATION OF A CERTAIN WALKWAY IN TRACT NO. 1818 IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE," which map is hereby approved for the purpose of this proceeding and is hereby ordered filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Torrance and marked "Filed May 3, 1955," and which map is hereby referred to for particulars as to the proposed vacation.

RESOLVED that the 24th day of May, 1955, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. of said day, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of the City of Torrance, is the time and place fixed when the City Council will meet to take final action hereon and which time

is more than fifteen days after the adoption of this Resolution; that at said time any objections that may be made to the vacation of said Walkway will be heard and passed on; and in the event all objections made and urged are overruled, the City Council of said City shall have jurisdiction to order said Walkway hereinafter described to be vacated.

RESOLVED that this Resolution be published once prior to the day fixed herein for the meeting of the said City Council, in a newspaper of general circulation, to-wit, the Torrance Herald, published in the City of Torrance, and that this Resolution be conspicuously posted along the boundaries of the Walkway hereinafter described to be vacated and not more than three hundred feet apart, and not less than three in all.

RESOLVED that in the herein proposed vacation of said Walkway, aforementioned, the Council of the City of Torrance hereby elects to proceed under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941 of the State of California (Chapter 250, Statutes of 1941) as amended.
