Courtesy and cooperation could practically eliminate our highway right-of-way problem."

California Highway Patrol Commissioner R. R. Caldwell yesterday chose these words to express the Patrol's growing concern over the continuing epidemic of right-of-way collisions.

"If we could prevail upon all motorists to display the same courtesy in driving that people normally show in their homes, much of the needless waste of life and property would be eliminated," Caldwell declared.

"Cooperation involves working with others and obeying the rules," he continued. "One of the right-of-way rules often violated governs situations when two vehicles enter an intersection at the same time.

"This rule requires the driver of the vehicle on the left to yield the right-of-way to the driver of the vehicle on the right. The same rule requires the driver of any vehicle approaching an intersection to yield the right-of-way to the driver of any vehicle already in the intersection."

The Commission said he had instructed every field commander to carefully tabulate the number of right-of-way violations and collisions resulting from these violations.

"Unless immediate improvement is realized the Patrol will have to make adjustments necessary to devote a greater share of enforcement toward arresting right-of-way violators," Caldwell said. "This type of driving behavior is inexcusable and cannot be tolerated."
