Board Plans Two Section High School

Plans to build the proposed South Torrance High school in two sections, with the first section to house ninth, tenth and possibly eleventh graders, in 1957, were approved by the Torrance School Board Tuesday night.

The action was taken, the educators said, to afford maximum use for classrooms and money. The first section would cost an estimated \$1,388,000, while the cost of the entire project is figured at \$2,500,000.

If the entire plant were built in 1957, the board was told, there would be empty classrooms in both South and North

High schools at first. At the same time, many elementary schools would still be on double session.

Proposed financing of the project would be from \$858,690 in federal funds and district funds of \$529,510.

Completing only one section—with 16 classrooms; two art

science, shop, and music rooms; a homemaking room, shower and locker facilities; library and custodial space—would house an estimated 700 to 800 students. These would include ninth, tenth, and possibly eleventh graders.
