A new non-commissioned officer-specialist pro-A new noncommissioned officer-specialist pro-gram, inaugurated by the Army, went into effect July 1.

July 1. Under the new program non-commissioned offi-cer identification and status is given only to enlisted personnel holding leadership positions. Those enlisted personnel who have technical and administrative skills will be classed in a category labeled specialists. The new classification is designed to give more prestige to the non-commissioned officer and the spe-cialist. It is hoped that the program will restore the traditional position of the non-commissioned officer as the backbone of the army. The top four pay grades in the separation of the NCO is effected by the new plan, but no pay will be lost in the conversion.
