

### HOUSE TRAILER OWNERS REMINDED OF DEADLINE

All owners and operators of house trailers are again reminded of the registration requirements of the new California law which became effective Sept. 7, 1955.

This law provides that all house trailers within the State of California become subject to registration and license fees regardless of whether or not they are operated or occupied. The law further provides that all such fees which become due Sept. 7, 1955, will be subject to penalties if not paid on or before Oct. 6, 1955, so all those who might come under this law are urged to check with any office of the California Department of Motor Vehicles before Oct. 6.

House trailers that are part of the manufacturer's or dealer's inventory are exempted from these provisions unless otherwise subject to registration.

### Local Men Enter Las Vegas Race

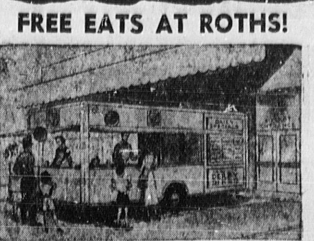

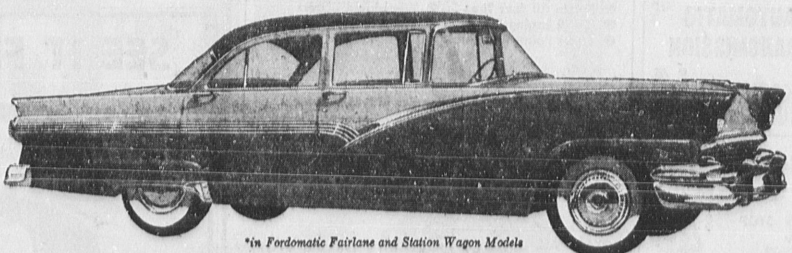
