

Area Workers Seek Muscular Dystrophy Aid

Scores of Torrance volunteers will start ringing doorbells throughout this area Sunday evening in a door-to-door march to appeal for contributions for the fight against the mysterious crippling disease, muscular dystrophy.

Mr. and Mrs. Edmund Ingalls, Southwestern area volunteer chairmen, said yesterday that the citizens' march for MD will continue for five consecutive nights through next Thursday.

They explained that this will be the local committee's principal effort in the annual program to help finance the patient aid and research of the Los Angeles County Chapter of the Muscular Dystrophy Association.

Ready to Start

The marchers under the Ingalls' direction have been receiving literature and instructions throughout the past week and will be ready to start their organized solicitation Sunday evening.

"Muscular dystrophy is a cruel disease about which little is known and its victims are mostly children," according to the Ingalls. "First there is a weakening of the muscles, then a stumbling walk, then gradually increasing paralysis until total disability is reached.

Hundreds Hit

"Hundreds of Los Angeles County youngsters and adults are victims of this baffling malady. They must remain helpless in their wheel chairs until a cure is found.

"Everyone can help speed up the search for a cure by giving generously. If the volunteer workers who are marching door-to-door are unable to find you home, you can help by mailing a contribution to the Muscular Dystrophy Association, Los Angeles 5.

The daffodil is a most satisfactory bulb for it is sure to bloom and to increase in numbers year after year and what is more the bulb flower's worst enemy, the gopher, won't harm the daffodil because of its bitter taste.

The other major bulb flowers, the iris, tuberous begonias, dahlias, and lilies, will surely please your green thumb friends too. If you'd like to make a rather unusual presentation of bulb flowers you might assemble a collection of early-flowering little bulbs, suggest the California Association of Nurseriesmen, such as the fragrant narcissus, the crocus, freesia, hyacinth of the muscari (grape hyacinth). Any and all of these bulb flowers will please your gardening friends and family on Christmas day.

Three members of a South Gate family received injuries Saturday night in a three-car crash-up on Pacific Coast Highway near Rolling Hills Rd.

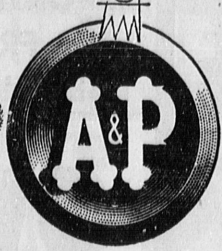
