

Southwest Savings Assets Soar Over \$30 Million Mark in 1955

Southwest Savings & Loan Assn., today reported that its assets now amount to \$30,520,132.91 or 29 per cent more than they were on Dec. 31, 1954.

Fred E. Edwards, president of the association, in releasing the report, said the institution's progress continued to be based on serving an increasing number of citizens "and serving them well."

"With each passing year," he added, "we serve a growing number of people, either by providing a safe, convenient, and profitable place for their savings, or by granting them loans on a sound basis for the purchase of homes."

Edwards listed highlights of the specialized thrift and home financing institution's 1955 operations as follows:

1. Net savings in 1955 increased by \$6,176,845.16 or 30 per cent bringing total savings to \$26,343,287.75.
2. The number of savings account holders increased to 10,222, a gain of 2072 or 25.4 per cent over the previous year.
3. Dividends paid out to savers totaled \$762,151.44.
4. Home loans increased both in number and amount, the total home loans outstanding now amounting to \$27,250,610.71.
5. Capital and reserves now amount to \$2,209,560.83 or 23 per cent more than at the end

of 1954. An "unusually good" year was forecast by Edwards for 1956—especially for the first six months, bolstered by a high month. The economic expansion of 1955 would continue, he level of plant and equipment expenditures, expanding inventories, a high rate of consumer spending, peak employment, and a high level of construction.

Contributing further to the optimistic business outlook Edwards said, were the facts that 1956 is an election year, and that tax reductions appear to be in the offing.

As for housing, Edwards reported that demand continues strong, being sustained by "an intense desire on the part of the public for up-to-date and larger homes, a rising rate of disposable personal income, and a continued high rate of family formation." While housing starts may decline to around 1.2 million units in 1956, down from 1955's production of 1.3 million units, the year would still go down as the country's third biggest home building year, he said.

"Despite some tightening of mortgage money, there will be plenty of funds available to finance the 1956 volume of home building," Edwards concluded.
