Douglas Gets New Skyraider Work for Navy

A new contract for an advanced version of the Navy's famed Skyraider series announced today by the Douglas Aircraft Co., extends for at least another year the longest continuous deliveries of any combat airplane now in production.

T. E. Springer, vice president-general manager of the company's El Segundo division, said that approximately 3000 of these carrier-based attack bombers have been built since 1946. The new Skyraider will be known as the AD-7 and deliveries are scheduled to begin in August, 1956. The AD-7 will be the 50th version of the popular "Able-Dog" series since the prototype first took to the air on March 18, 1945.

Among basic differences, compared with the AD-6, are an improved Wright R-3350-28WB reciprocating engine that provides added power, and "beefed-up" wings to prolong service life under higher tactical loads.

Although current Skyraiders outwardly resemble those of a decade ago, their equipment, speed and performance are considerably improved. The airplane was originally designed to carry 1000-pound bomb loads, but later versions have carried bomb arrangements of over

GP Purchases Wilmington Gas

General Petroleum Corp. has purchased the capital stock of Wilmington Gasoline Co., R. L. Minckler, president of General Petroleum Corp., announced this week.

The stock was purchased from the Chicago North Shore System, Inc., a transportation holding company, which had purchased the assets of the Wilmington Gasoline Co. in the spring of 1954.

The Wilmington Gasoline Co. operates a natural gasoline plant on Terminal Island to process gas produced in the Terminal Island section of the Wilmington oil field.

General Petroleum Corp. will operate the Wilmington Gasoline Co. as a subsidiary.

Newly elected officers and directors of the gasoline company are R. L. Minckler, president; P. S. Magruder and R. O. Swayze, vice presidents; Paul E. Birmingham, vice president and solicitor; A. D. Bannison, treasurer; M. W. Kibre, secretary, and E. H. Berge, director. All are executives of General Petroleum Corp. of which Magruder is executive vice president and Swayze, a vice president.
