Wins First For GENERAL EXCELLENCE IN STATE!

The top award for community newspapers in the State of California—given by Sigma Delta Chi honorary journalism fraternity for General Excellence — was won by THE TORRANCE HERALD at the recently-concluded California Newspaper Publishers Association Convention at Hotel del Coronado, San Diego. A record-breaking total of 436 newspapers was entered in the various classifications for rating. Second place rating in the General Excellence division was given to the Van Nuys News, with the Lompoc Record and South Gate Press being awarded Honorable Mention. The San Jose News won the General Excellence award for daily California newspapers. Presentation of the plaque was made to King Williams, HERALD publisher, by Lieutenant Governor Harold J. Powers at a breakfast meeting Saturday attended by more than 700 convention registrants.
