Board Okays Steel in New Classrooms

Classrooms

Steel portable buildings, which can be moved easier and maintained more cheaply, will be built at Torrance as additions to Torrance schools in the future, the Board of Education decided at a special meeting Monday.

The steel buildings were recommended to the board for 18 classrooms to be built at Arington, Hillside, Flavian, Sepulveda, and Anza Schools. These units will help to relieve double sessions at those schools. If and when the enrollment drops at schools where the units are built and they are needed at some other school, they can be picked up and moved to another site; in the past, the district has been faced with the problem of having a few extra classrooms in one area, such as Torrance Elementary School, but lacking them in other areas where they are badly needed because of double sessions.

In the past, wood and concrete portable classrooms have been built at local schools. The board was told that steel buildings are the coming thing in school construction and are cheaper to maintain.


