Both the sales and net income of the National Supply Co. in 1956 broke all records, it was announced following a meeting of the board of directors in Pittsburgh Friday.

At the meeting, the directors declared a quarterly dividend of 60 cents per share on the new \$5 par value common stock, payable April 1 to stock-holders of record March 20. This is equivalent to a quarterly rate of \$1.20 per share on the former \$10 par value common stock, which was split two-for-one effective Jan. 16. In the corresponding period of 1956, the company paid a 75 cent quarterly dividend on the \$10 par value stock.

Sales during 1956 totaled \$222.884.044, compared with 1955 sales of \$259.802.686, the previous record. Net income before taxes was \$31,812.364, compared with the 1955 net income of \$11,443.492. The previous record, \$12,227,362, was made in 1948.
