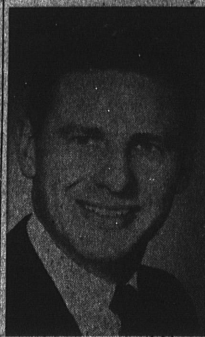
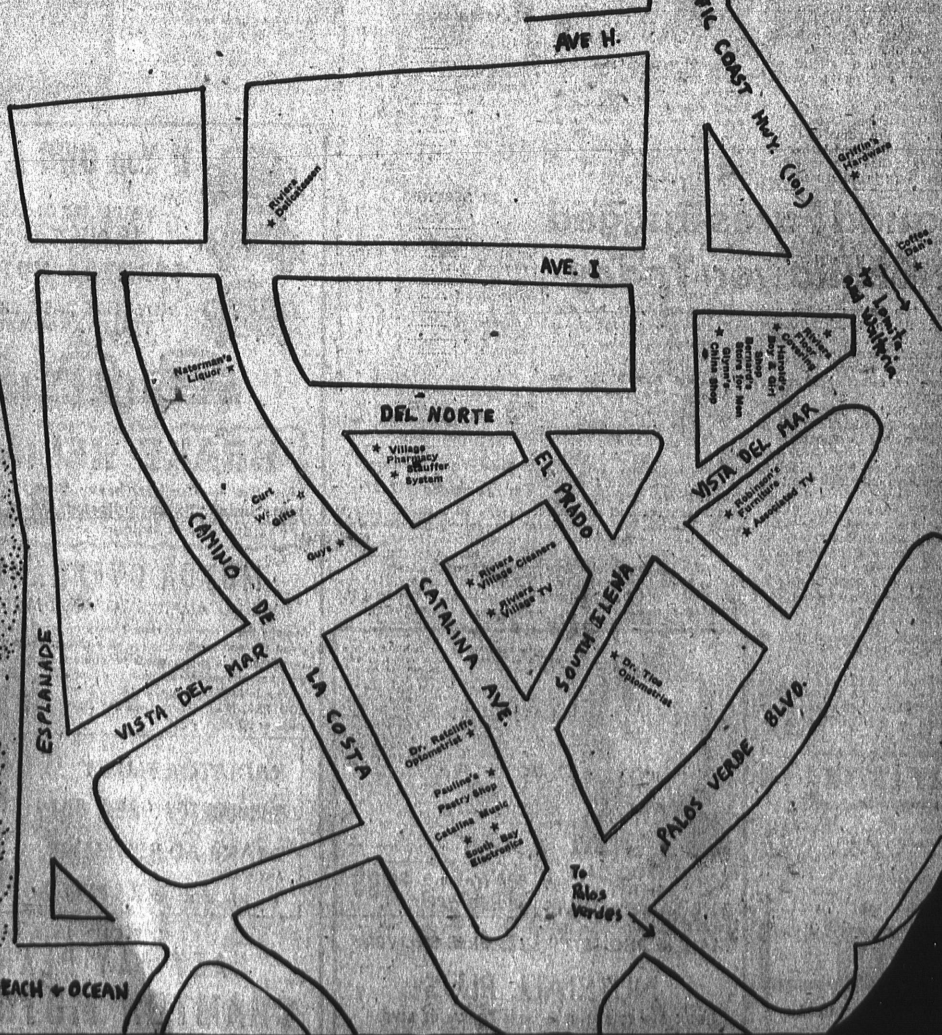
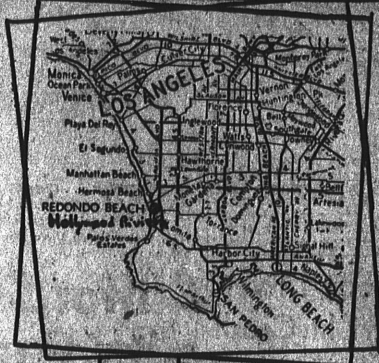
been delayed; a meeting of the Tennis Club, scheduled for
