"It will replace the wall charts used up to the present time in giving the sight tests required by state law. The legislator said that the transportation committees of both the Senate and Assembly cannot diagnose vision defects and that they should not recommend types of treatment. Checks Basic Sight "The state's vision screeping test is designed to demonstrate to the individual seeking a driver's slicense the general condition of his vision." he said. "If the basic test indicates a defect may exist, the ilcense examiner informs the applicant that a license cannot be issued unless the condition is corrected.
