**Serra Mothers Installation**

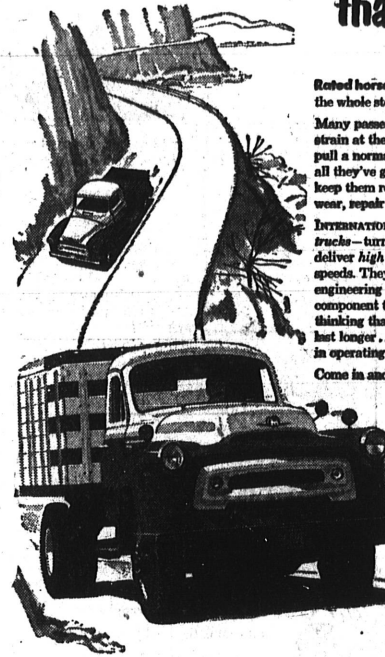
