by Veterans Affairs will start making loans on July 5 to two groups: veterans who, because of a wartime disability or wound, are not subject to size-of-loan priority, and veterans who request loans not exceed-ing \$10,000 for a home or \$20,-000 for a farm. All other ex-servicemen's ap-plication cards will go on a waiting list, Mrs. Helen Dill, director here, said, until some time after a \$500,000,000 vet-erans' bond issue is approved in November. Those requesting lesser amounts of funds will be first to be considered for financing at a later date.
