Today when there are crying shortages of skilled help—draftsmen, laboratory technicians—when, on the other hand, there are fewer teachers than are needed to meet the challenge of our schools—it is our duty both as parents, interested in the welfare of our children, and as citizens, interested in the welfare of our country, to help set our youngsters on the right track.

As parents, we have a two-fold responsibility: To cooperate with the school authorities in informing our children about new and expanding occupational fields, and to help our children relate their own abilities to these careers.

Can Be Started Early
Such vocational guidance can be started very early in a child's life by introducing him to people in varied fields of work, by giving him career books suitable for his age level, taking him on field trips, even choosing toys that will forward his career.

Bear in mind, that a child's career should not be imposed upon him. We should keep our own ambitions for our children in check if we want our children to be happy in their chosen work.

There are some 40,000 different jobs in our economic structure. Each is important, no matter whether it is administrative, professional, clerical, skilled, semi-skilled or unskilled.

No one particular type should be over-emphasized to a child. His personality will lead him to the work he thinks he will like.
