## Plan Family Day Sunday

## Sermon Says Evil Godless

"God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind" asserts the Apostle Paul to Timothy in a reference which is the Golden Text of the Lesson-Sermon on "Unreality" in all Christian Science churches, Sunday.

In the Gospel of John the opening verses declare, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made."

A companion passage to this Scriptural quotation will be read from the Christian Science textbook, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy. "In the Gospel of John, it is declared that all things were made through the Word of God, and without Him (the logos, or word) was not anything made that was made. Everything good or worthy, God made. Whatever is valueless or baneful, He did not make, —hence its unreality."
