Disabled veterans may have heard about total disability payments which will be made under the Social Security Act, to persons between the ages of 50 and 65 who can no longer work for a living. Actually this benefit will not start until July 1987, said Mrs. Helen K. Dill, director of the Torrance area Veterans Service Center today.

She warned, too, that when Social Security disability payments start, the amount of other federal disability benefits — including compensation and pension—is to be deducted from the person's disability entitlement under the Social Security law.
