## Employ the Handicapped' Week Slated

Goodwill Industries of the Harbor and Bay area will demonstrate to the community the theme of National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week, Oct. 7-to. 13, that "ability, ned disability counts," Walter Case, executive director, declared Friday.

In training or being employed in the sheltered workshops of the non-profit Goodwill Industries are more than 100 handicapped men and women performing work operations similar to those in main fields of business or industry. Employers Encouraged Handicapped people are encouraged to move on to normal employment, Case said He added that NEPH Week program is important as a means of encouraging employers to hire handicapped people after their Goodwill Industries training.

training.

As a sheltered workshop.
Goodwill Industries also provides longer term employment for handicapped people whose disabilities make normal work difficult. Compensation to workers is in accord with standards established for handicapped workers under the wage and hour law, Case explained.

Job Therapy Cited

Many of the handicapped worked before coming to Goodwill Industries, he reported. So job therapy along with specific training is of utmost importance. Impairments among employes include generally orthopedic and organic sight hearing and speech defects mental, emotional unbalance and age.
