

### Groundbreaking Held for New 68-Unit Apartments

Groundbreaking ceremonies were held Monday for a new 68-unit apartment development at Redondo Beach Blvd. and Ainsworth Ave., to be known as Torrance Manor. According to Builder Wayne L. Nelson, the apartments will cost a million dollars and be of the "Beverly Hills type." They will include such built-in features as ovens, ranges, intercom systems, and indoor-outdoor living provided by separate patios for each unit.

County Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, Mayor Albert Isen, Chamber of Commerce President A. E. Thompson, and Sharon Smith, "Miss Chamber of Commerce," were on hand at the ceremonies.

Wayne L. Nelson, the builder; L. C. Major and Associates, the designer; and the Barclay Engineering Co., engineers, were represented, as was the financier, Theodore Kleiner. Jack Spahn of Barclay Engineering conducted the ceremonies, with Father Raymond Tepe delivering the invocation. Mayor Albert Isen turned the first shovel of earth with a gold shovel.

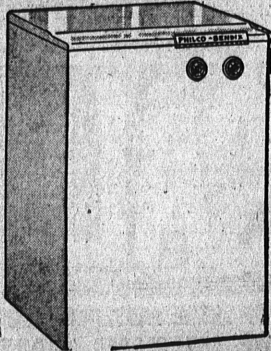
